The Biennial Exhibition.

Rules

This exhibition is held in alternate years and is judged by an independent judge.

1. All entrants must be a member of a club that is affiliated to the LPA.
2. An entry may be up to three colour and/or three monochrome prints making a maximum entry of 6 prints in total. There is no set theme and the exhibition is 'open'.
3. All prints must be on 20 x16 inch mounts to fit LPA frames. (50 x 40cm will not fit *current* frames and so will be ineligible.) *This may change if new frames are purchased.*
4. Where the entrant is a member of more than one LPA affiliated club or society they may only enter from one club.
5. On the back of each print must be the entrants name, club and title of the print. There should be no marking on the front. A monochrome print is defined as Black and white print either toned or un-toned with or without the addition of one colour.
6. *There will be no charge for entering the exhibition.*
7. The judge's decision will be final.
8. No print must have been previously accepted for the LPA Biennial exhibition and sole copyright must be in the author's ownership.
9. Glass goblets will be presented to the winners of each section and Glass goblets awarded for the judge's selections.
