The Foster's Trophy Colour Challenge.

Rules

This is a club Competition for colour prints. The competition is held in April each year at Horncastle.

RULES

1. Prints may be conventionally or digitally produced and may be home or trade processed. The entries must be colour prints as defined by the Royal Photographic Soc. & the PAGB.
2. Prints must be no smaller than 10 inches on its longest side and no larger than 20x16 inches. Mounts shall be no larger than 20x16 inches.
3. Prints must not be more than two years old by the date of the competition *and may have been entered in other LPA competitions other than the Foster's Challenge.*
4. Each print must have, on the back, the title of the picture, the name of the author and the club from which it is entered.
5. The Sixth print will only be used in the event of a tie.
6. No photographer may enter more than two prints and all must be members of the competing club at the time of the competition. No photographer may represent more than one club in any given year.
7. Each participating club shall submit details of their entry by due date.
8. All prints must be booked into the competition venue by 7.00 PM. on the night.
9. Each participating club may send up to four representatives to the competition.
10. Once submitted no changes will be allowed to a club's entry.
11. A charge is made for this competition and is noted on the entry form.

COMPETITION PROCEDURE

1. There will be four knockout rounds in each of which the judge will eliminate prints from the competition.
2. Prints will earn points depending on how they progress through the knockout rounds.
3. Prints eliminated in Round One will earn one point, two points in Round Two, three points in Round Three and four points in Round Four.
4. At the end of Round Four each of the remaining prints will receive five points. The judge will then select the best print overall, which will receive an additional point.
5. The winning club will be that with the highest total points.
6. In the event of a tie the sixth print will be judged and a further point awarded to the winner.
